THREE ANAJALI CHILDREN HURT IN MOTORCYCLE ACCIDENT.

An early morning motorcycle accident sent Brenda (Class 8) and her two brothers Ambrose and Moses (Class 4) to the hospital along with their father. Admission and treatment in a hospital requires money up front. Fortunately money had been wired just two days before to be used as needed. Brenda and Ambrose have returned to class but Moses is still in the hospital with head injuries. Pray for his healing.

Bayhach Dede, the son of the assistant pastor and his wife at the Anajali Church needs surgery to take care of a painful birth defect. The doctor says that the surgery cannot be put off much longer, but \$300 is needed. Will you consider helping with this need?

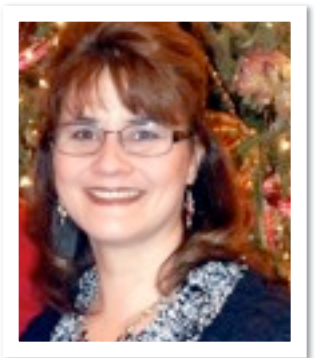

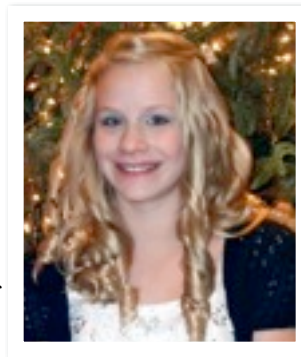

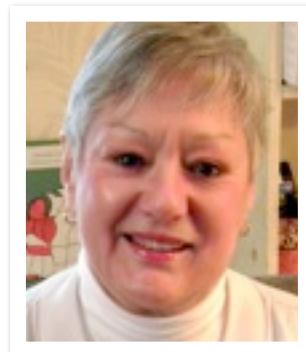

Susan will be working with the special education program she began in the school last year as well as helping with construction. She also will assist team leader Anne Blodgett as needed.



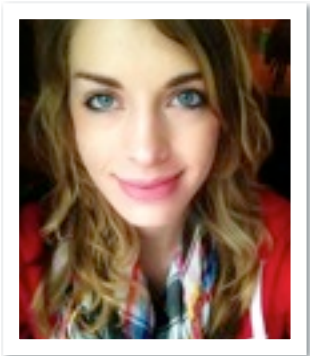
