## Summer Mission Trip - June 2012



Team leader Anne Blodgett along with six people from the Green Mountain Community Alliance Church in Waterbury, VT and Christopher and Haily Lincoln from Laconia, New Hampshire will arrive in Scotland, CT at the Anajali Ministries headquarters on

June 26. Last minute packing as well as preparing as a team will fill our time before heading out to JFK to board our flight the evening of 28th of June.

Pray for us as we pack 450 pair of flip-flops, 200 pair of white socks for the girls at Anajali, gifts and letters for sponsored students, microscopes, recorders, knitting and sewing supplies, school supplies, toothbrushes and

toothpaste and as many as possible of the other items donated to Anajali. We will be purchasing socks in Nairobi for the boys as they wear a special uniform sock that is not available here.

#### Gifts for Children

If you sponsor a child at the Anajali School, or would like to encourage a child at Anajali, put together a packet of school supplies and have them to the Anajali office in Scotland, CT by June 24, 2012. All items must be taken out of the original packaging and be placed in zip-lock plastic bags and then put in a gallon size plastic zip-lock bag. If you have a particular child in mind, place the child's name on a piece of paper inside the bag so that it can be clearly seen. Items that are acceptable are pencils, erasers, composition book, crayons, soap, small stuffed animal, picture of yourself, and letter from you (please do not use the word "sponsor" in any communication.) You may also send a fleece blanket with the child's name attached to it. Fleece blankets do not need to be in the plastic bag.

# IN LOVING MEMORY OF JANICE CLARK




